### **EARLY YEARS PROGRAM**

Facilitating early childhood education and maternal-child health programs through a First Nations cultural lens in Whitehorse and several communities.

#### **CULTURAL CONNECTIONS**

Supporting cultural programming for all Indigenous youth across the territory.

### MOBILE THERAPEUTIC UNIT

Providing Indigenous-led allied health services for all Yukon communities, including cultural mental wellness services, speech language pathology, occupational therapy, education psychology, vision and hearing screening.

# URBAN AND RURAL NUTRITION PROGRAM

Providing equitable and healthy food to all Indigenous children aged 0 to 18 through in-school meal services, food hampers, family feasts, and the promotion of traditional practices like seasonal harvesting, preservation and meal preparation.

## FIRST NATION EDUCATION ADVOCATES

Building strong, resilient, successful, life-long learners by offering academic and wellness supports, First Nations cultural connections and programming, and land-based learning opportunities.
